RE: Separation of Senior Council Districts

On April 21, 2022, the Board of Directors of the Senior Services Council of San Juan County (SSCSJC) voted to transfer the operational functions of its three District Committees to three stand-alone nonprofit organizations. The purpose of this decision is to better and more efficiently serve seniors and people living with disabilities on Lopez, Orcas and San Juan Islands. The transition is anticipated to occur with minimal disruption to client services and business partners.

During the transition period, Board members of the SSCSJC corporation and its existing District Committees will reach out to business partners, contractors, donors and grant makers to review and update agreements that are currently in place. We will work together to revise and confirm agreements reflecting the appropriate new entities that will work together. Again, our goal is to continue and improve the services we provide.

If you are a grant maker and have an active grant agreement with us, we appreciate that you may consider the final outcome of this process to be a material change. We look forward to discussing any changes necessary to the grant documents to ensure fulfillment of the objectives of your grant to the corporation
